

## TAILGATING RULES

### - One Permit = One Space for One Vehicle

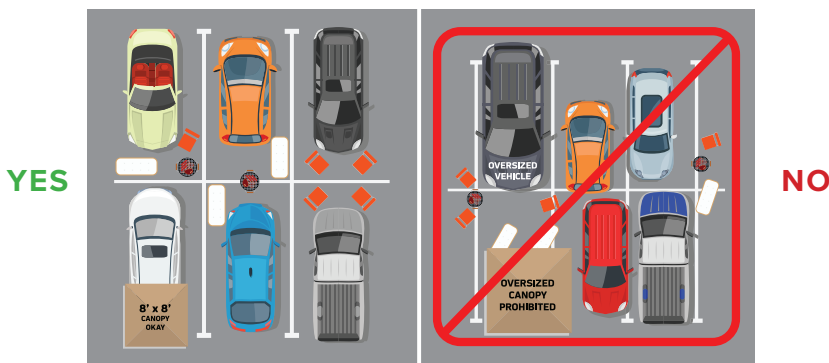
(fans may not occupy parking spaces with tailgate equipment like grills, tables, etc.)

- Tailgaters should back their vehicles into the exterior/perimeter parking spaces and tailgate in the landscaped areas, not in the unoccupied parking spaces next to you.
- Drive aisles and file lanes need to be kept clear at all times to allow emergency vehicles unobstructed access.
- Barbecue grills are allowed; however, their use in areas where guests or property may be damaged is strictly prohibited.
- All tailgate parties must conclude 60 minutes prior to kickoff. Tents, tables, chairs, etc. must be broken down prior to entering the stadium.

- Parking spaces are first-come, first-served. Fans may not block or save spaces. Vehicles may be directed to exterior parking spaces in designated tailgate areas within the parking lots upon arrival.

### NOT ALLOWED

- Saving or blocking parking spaces, drive lanes, pedestrian aisle ways, sidewalks or disabled access aisles.
- Kegs, glass bottles, open flame fires or weapons of any kind.
- Open flame fires of any kind or the use of grills **in areas where guests or property may be damaged.**
- Commercial activity of any kind (including, but not limited to advertising, promotion, solicitation, etc. without advance, written approval by the Denver Broncos).



## FAN CODE OF CONDUCT

Broncos Stadium at Mile High and the Denver Broncos are committed to creating a safe, comfortable and enjoyable experience for all fans, both in the stadium and in the parking lot. Therefore, a Fan Code of Conduct exists for all guests. The following behaviors will not be tolerated at Broncos Stadium at Mile High:

- Behavior that is unruly, disruptive or illegal in nature.
- Intoxication or other signs of alcohol or substance impairment that results in irresponsible behavior.
- Foul, obscene, offensive or abusive language, gestures or actions.
- Interfering with the progress of the game or throwing any object onto the field or in the stadium premises.
- Failing to follow the instructions of stadium personnel.
- Verbal or physical harassment of opposing team fans.
- Smoking, except in designated areas.
- Fighting.
- Indecent exposure or the wearing of obscene or indecent clothing.
- Conduct that endangers spectators or participants.
- Ethnic intimidation.



Event patrons are responsible for their conduct as well as the conduct of their guests and / or persons occupying their seats. Event patrons and guests who violate these provisions will be subject to ejection without refund, potential loss of ticket and parking privileges for future games, and possible revocation of their season ticket account.
